FENC has dedicated itself to non-profit and charitable causes for half a century with the belief of "benefiting from the society, returning benefits to the society". By tapping into the Company's core strength and infusing capital, we promote public wellbeing, expand on international perspectives and improve competitiveness for the society as a whole, which will help us invent a new century.

5.1 Social Engagement at FENC Sites

FENC has long maintained a good relationship with local communities at its business locations, engaging community organizations and providing resources, such as offering venues for community assembly or fire drill. We help the underprivileged members of the community. We also conduct beach cleanup campaigns and help schools and local neighborhoods clean their environment, fully utilizing our strength to raise public awareness on environmental protection and recycling. In 2020, the volunteered hours among the volunteers of all business sites amounted to 4,151 hours. The followings are the key events held in 2020

FENC had an active presence in community activities in 2020. To name a few, Hsinpu Chemical Fiber Plant attended the lantern festival celebration in Hsinpu during the lunar New Year. Hukou Mill participated in the year-end non-profit event in Hsinchu County. FEAZ has been supporting Suzhou Wuzhong District Social Welfare Institute for years, and in 2020, the plant donated face masks to help the institute fight the COVID-19 pandemic. FEDZ made dumplings with members of local care facility for people with disabilities. FEPV brought gifts to disadvantaged students during the lunar New Year and Mid-Autumn Festival.

Lecturer at UN SDGs & ESD Training Workshop



FENC was invited to lecture at 2020 UN SDGs & ESD (Education for Sustainable Development) Training Workshop for Professional Teachers On August 13th, 2020.

This event was held by CTCI Education Foundation, and co-organized by Education for Climate Change Program supported by the Ministry of Education. Over 40 teachers from schools around Taiwan participated in this 2-day workshop. FENC has been working on UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for an extended period of time, and developed FENC Sustainability Strategy Blueprint accordingly. With Green and Sustainable Business Model as the lecture topic, FENC shared its efforts on SDGs, giving participants a glimpse of corporate efforts on developing SDGs in Taiwan. The attending teachers learned about case studies and acquired background knowledge through interactive games, and will shared them with the younger generations in schools.

In addition, on June 5th, 2020, FENC was invited to speak at Aletheia University, speaking to over 100 students on The Truth about CSR. During the lecture, FENC explained the significance of corporate social responsibilities to corporations and the global community, and discussed FENC's circular economy practices.

The 2 events gave the young students and teachers a deeper understanding in corporate sustainability, planting the seeds of hope for a sustainable future.

Demonstrating Focus on Water Resources at OPTC by Attending Water Campaigns



OPTC is concerned about how water resources are utilized and dedicated to its corporate social responsibility by committing to water recycling and reuse, increasing water recycling rate, and taking part in community campaigns on water resources conservation.

In November 2020, OPTC attended 2020 Caota Sand Dunes Beach Cleanup/Carbon Reduction, Energy and Water Conservation Campaign held by Taoyuan City Government. OPTC staff and their families participated in this event, promoting environmental protection and holding trivial pursuit games with prizes. The campaign introduced the slogan, "Care for the land, clean up the earth." It is the hope to encourage the participants to take actions and protect the coastal environment. OPTC took the opportunity to share its philosophy on the conservation of coastal habitat and enhance environmental education.

In 2020, OPTC also helped environmental advocates and academic institutions on the research of algal reef and protect the estuary of Hsinwu River. Meanwhile, OPTC also signed water reclamation contract with Taoyuan North District Water Resources Recovery Center, pledging to support the reuse of water resources. By participating in the various campaigns, OPTC has demonstrated its commitment to protecting water resources.

2020 marks the 12th year of FENC Classic Marathon. Though the threat of COVID-19 still looms over Taiwan, it didn't deter the runners from participating. The 2020 FENC Classic Marathon was held on October 24th, and once again the event took place at Hsinpu Chemical Fiber Plant. Considering the risk of clustering during the pandemic, we minimize the risk and ensure runners' safety. We also packed with tug of war, basketball games, and some fun games that filled the day with fun and gave staff a chance to bond with each other. We Worked with the local chapter of Huashan Social Welfare Foundation, FENC initiated a charity drive to help local seniors who live alone.

APG Polytech's Long-Term Community Program



In 2018, FENC acquired APG Polytech in West Virginia, U.S. The plant has been operating for 61 years prior to the acquisition, and has formed a strong bond with the local community with long-term support.

Many children from the local community had long dreamt of becoming farmers. APG Polytech helped make this dream a reality. These children received the opportunity to care for a farm, and sell produce and meat products. The proceeds are then used towards their education.



Whenever APG Polytech has the opportunity, the plant donates food to Crosslight of Hope, a community NGO that provides assistance to local families in need. In 2020, APG Polytech donated over 135 kilograms of food and a brand new refrigerator. Additionally, the plant donated money, sportswear and toys to local schools, sports teams and children, and provided USD\$1,000 in scholarship each for 8 college students, co-creating a better community.

5.2.1 Youth Talent

Establish educational institutes that facilitate diverse and adaptive learning- Oriental Institute of Technology/Yu Chang Technical and Commercial Vocational Senior High School/Yuan Ze University

FENC values diverse and adaptive learning, encouraging students to apply what they have learned to achieve self-fulfillment. Over the years, the Company has established Oriental Institute of Technology, Yu Chang Technical and Commercial Vocational Senior High School and Yuan Ze University, providing students with options in terms of the right educational environment based on career development to bridge the gap between what students learn at schools and the skills required at the workplace. Since 2012, the affiliates of Far Eastern Group expanded the practical training program for students. As of today, 759 students have participated in the industry-academia internship program, and entered the companies after graduation. Such programs have created win-win for students, corporations and the society. (Please refer to 4.1.2 Recruitment Policy.)

For years, Oriental Institute of Technology and Far Eastern Group maintain a collaborative partnership, providing industry-academia projects to faculty members and internship opportunities to students. A presentation was held during the anniversary celebration for Oriental Institute of Technology in 2020. During the event, Oriental Square VR Tour System provided hands-on experience that shed light on the industry-academia collaboration and interdisciplinary research that the institute is currently conducting, while cultivating research talents and elevating the development of all disciplines.

In 2020, the school celebrates its 50th anniversary. Students and teachers from the sophomore class visited the original school site in Shifen, Pingxi District. The site visit allows students to understand the history of the school, and builds common memories and identity across generations. They brightened up a peaceful day in a small town.

Colleges and universities are incubators of pillars of the society. They are also the driving force that propels the society forward. Through university social responsibility (USR) projects, universities also serve as community think tank that drives regional development. In 2020, Student Affairs Department of Yuan Ze University co-hosted the second USR Inter-school Seminar on Cultivating Localization and Sustainable Practice with the Department of Youth Affairs of Taoyuan City Government. A total of 24 USR teams from the colleges and universities in Taiwan attended the event. Programs include insightful keynote speeches as well as project highlights shared by 7 USR teams. Through in-depth exchange and observation, the hope is that momentum from these educational institutions will converge to serve the society and build a model practice for fulfilling social responsibilities.

Shining International Spotlight onto Taiwan with International Competitions- Taiwan Young Student Physicists' Tournament

To build a solid foundation in science education among young students, Y. Z. Hsu Science and Technology Memorial Foundation started the Y. Z. Hsu Competition-Taiwan Young Student Physicists' Tournament in 2009 with the Department of Physics, National Taiwan Normal University. The competition is open to high school student teams around the nation. Students who perform well during the competition will be recruited to the national team, which will train with professors from National Taiwan Normal University, and compete in International Young Physicists' Tournament (IYPT).

The twelve questions for contestants of Taiwan Young Student Physicists' Tournament are selected from the 17 questions published by IYPT. The tournament attracts students from top high schools each year. They conduct experiment or simulation based on each question; report and debate over their findings with other contestants during the tournament. As of 2020, the 12th year of the tournament, the event has attracted 1,685 contestants and awarded NT\$11.91 million in prizes. The 2020 National Team won the IYPT bronze medal for Taiwan. Y. Z. Hsu Science and Technology Memorial Foundation has been sponsoring food, accommodation and transportation for the IYPT national team members. The students were exceptional, winning 1 gold, 5 silver and 5 bronze medals.

Y. Z. Hsu Science and Technology Memorial Foundation hosted the first Y. Z. Hsu Innovation Forum in 2013 to encourage youth to enter the field of science and technology and create a new future for the next generation. In 2020, Y. Z. Hsu Innovation Forum expands its outreach to the younger generation. For the first time in its history, FENC brought the forum to senior high schools, including Taipei Municipal Datong High School and Taipei First Girls High School. This arrangement gives high school students exposure to diverse technological fields. Winners of Y. Z. Hsu Science Award are invited as speakers and panelists to share their experience and legacy, inspiring young students to embrace emerging technological industries. 5.2.2 Industry Evolution

Encourage Academia to Accelerate Technological Research, Development and Innovation- Y.Z. Hsu Science Award

Far Eastern Y. Z. Hsu Science and Technology Memorial Foundation is founded on the mission to promote "technology and innovation." Since 2002, the foundation has been presenting Y. Z. Hsu Science Award to encourage the academia for dedication in innovative research and development in the technological fields. The foundation consistently exerts efforts and resources into the cause, making Y. Z. Hsu Science Award one of the most prominent awards in scientific research in Taiwan. As this award marches into its 18th year in 2020, it is now one of the most significant technology awards in Taiwan. Over 241 scholars and experts participated in the peer review, and chose 30 winners for Science Chair Professor, Science Paper Award, Yuan Ze Chair Professor and Outstanding Professor Award. Among them, winners of Y. Z. Hsu Science Chair Professor received NT\$11.4 million. Over the 18 years of the award history, 388 awards have been presented with NT\$160 million in prize money, which is a remarkable record.

Establish Medical Institutes to Bolster Quality of Medical Service- Far Eastern Memorial Hospital/Far Eastern Polyclinic

In the 1970s, there was a lack of modernized large-scale hospitals in New Taipei City, and patients in serious or emergency conditions had to be diverted to Taipei City. The delay in treatment often led to tragedies. Therefore, Y. Z. Hsu, founder of Far Eastern Group, established Far Eastern Medical Foundation and set out on the mission to build hospitals, provide emergency medical service, offer pro bono healthcare for the disadvantaged and encourage medical research. In 1981, the foundation established Far Eastern Memorial Hospital in Banqiao District; in 1988, Far Eastern Polyclinic in Taipei City.

Currently, Far Eastern Memorial Hospital is the only medical center in New Taipei City. It is also a medical facility that is recognized by National Quality Award. Over the years, the hospital has grown into a large-scale medical center with 64 specializations, two centers and 1,174 hospital beds. Each month, the hospital conducts approximately 3,200 surgeries. Daily medical appointments reach over 5,000. The hospital continues to provide patient-centric healthcare, develop AI medical applications, and build smart hospitals with healthcare models and services that enhance patient experience. The hospital also utilizes data analysis as a supplement to boost agility in decision making and provide more efficient prescription service. Therefore, Far Eastern Memorial Hospital won the 2020 National Healthcare Quality Award in the Emergency and Outpatient Service category under Smart Hospital. Additionally, Far Eastern Polyclinic formed medical alliance with National Taiwan University Hospital to continue improving the quality of medical service and fulfill its social responsibility.

5.2.3 Social Development

Interdisciplinary Dialogue to Create Livable, Inclusive and Sustainable Environment- Far Eastern International Forum for Architecture

Far Eastern International Forum for Architecture, which is held by Y. Z. Hsu Science and Technology Memorial Foundation, approaches architecture through diverse perspectives. The 2020 forum on Art Reconstruction Design explores uncertainties as well as future trends and changes derived from the COVID-19 pandemic while pondering the boundary between "art" and "design". This boundary, which used to be clearly defined, is dissolving. Will such phenomenon pose significant influence to human society in the present and future? Will the two disciplines intertwine further into carriers of greater mission? With this forum as the medium, the foundation will continue to explore the impact of social issues on architectural design in the future.

Far Eastern International Forum for Architecture invited 10 prominent artists and architectural scholars from Japan and Taiwan to explore the present and future of art and design as the boundary between them dissolves in an increasingly diverse and fragmented society. Though Director Yuki Akimoto from Japan was not able to attend, he still contributed with a pre-recorded lecture. The fruitful exchange broadened the students' perspectives and elevated the emphasis on the cultural connotation of architectural design among the public, generating intellectual stimulation for Taiwan in the post-pandemic era. Chairman Douglas Tong Hsu, who has a strong penchant for art, praised the exceptional performance of the young artists at the event.

Rural-Urban Development, Local Revitalization- Keelung Taiping International Workshop

In search of opportunities for industries in port villages and mountain towns, and to provide care for aging communities, Far Eastern Memorial Foundation began collaborating with Yuan Ze University as well as Keelung City Government and launched Keelung Taiping International Workshop in 2019. The workshop, now in its 5th round, focuses on spatial revitalization, industry innovation and long-term care, and the 2020 workshop added local revitalization into issues discussed. With Keelung Taiping Elementary School and the Taiping community as the fields of experiment, the local revitalization team conducted interviews and residence programs, inviting local residents and artisans to co-work and co-create. Lane 113, Zhongshan 1st Road is identified as the corridor that connects the elementary school to the downtown of this port village. This team designated this corridor as "the road to the mountains, and the road home," and renovated the public facilities and vacant buildings along this road. The team also organized Taiping Market 2.0 at a scale three times larger than the 2018 event. Local residents and businesses opened the market together and promoted issues related to the aging population. The market offered 250 hand-printed T-shirts as a reward for participants who explored Taiping community and efforts of local revitalization. To get the free T-shirt, visitors must finish collecting stamps from designated locations on the local map they receive. Among the 70 booths at the market, 60 are from local vendors and 10 are local residents. In addition to offering products at the booths, the event also includes exhibitions, fashion shows, live performances and DIYs. The fashion shows focus on environmental protection with long-time local residents as the models featuring clothing made with used fishing net, fabric and ocean waste (buoy). Eight lectures were held with renowned architects such as the husband-and-wife team, Hsu-Yuan Kuo and Effie Huang as speakers. They shared their views on landscape architecture and spatial revitalization with actual case studies. A total of 600 participants attended the programs held during the event.
